2012 MRL WORKSHOP - WRAP UP AND ACTION ITEMS

- Speed up MRL process in Japan
- Make Codex the standard
- Clear Chinese standards; greater transparency and closer to global process
- Eliminate duplicate review across globe; EU presents barriers to international trade
- Increase grower utilization of USDA-EPA MRL database
- Evaluate possibility of adding import tolerances to MRL database as collaborative effort with importers
- Note that registrants "wish" to share data, but it is not necessarily available
- Increase grower participation at international level
- Document forums to provide pressure and feedback to regulatory agencies and governments
- Push for food safety throughout the world
- Increase consumer education regarding value and importance of MRLs
- Commodities and agriculture must speak up, be present at the table and vocal
