

# USDA-EPA MRL Database MRLDatabase.com

- Added Customs Union market to database
  - Russia
  - Kazakhstan
  - Belarus
- Select both Russia and Customs Union if you are searching for Russian MRLs
- Defer to Customs Union MRL for Russia if Russia has a different MRL value set




# USDA-EPA MRL Database MRLDatabase.com

- Working with EPA to add field trial residue notes for some specific trade irritant situations.
- For example,
  - US tomato MRL 0.9 ppm set on fruiting vegetables group
  - Canada tomato MRL 0.2 ppm set on tomato

# USDA-EPA MRL Database MRLDatabase.com


- Funding ends December 2014


### **US Grower Priority Database**


- US growers will be able to post global MRL priorities
  - China, Codex, Japan, South Korea,
    Taiwan, and Canada
- Will be launched August 2013



## Features for Setting Priorities


- View US MRLs with corresponding foreign MRLs for priority country
  - Pending, revoked, and proposed MRLs included
- Growers set priority for obtaining or revising an MRL in a market
  - Set priorities by active ingredient for multiple commodities
  - Very high; High; Intermediate; Low
  - Comments
- Multiple grower associations able to set priorities on same Al/commodity





### Features for Registrant Comments

- Registrants will create a profile of active ingredients
  - Will be notified by email when new or changed priorities set by growers
- Registrants will login to submit comments and run reports
- Multiple registrants may submit comments for same grower priority
